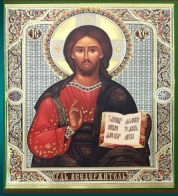

## FROM FATHER PETER

Summer 2024

### THE BEST DISINFECTANT

Now that summer is upon us, we look forward to enjoying some sunny Michigan weather (although, somehow, we manage to start complaining about the heat). It seems that we are never satisfied, and that complaining is in our DNA.

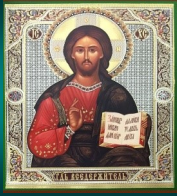
How much more cheerful, how much more hopeful, we feel when we are in sunlight – enjoying its warmth and its illumination. But more than this, “sunlight is the best disinfectant”, as one saying goes.

Though you can assume this saying refers to various bugs, insects and germs in our environment, this phrase has also been used in situations where something is happening that people are trying to hide or disguise some behavior, dysfunction, or activity.

Exposure of these brings them to our attention. But bringing such things to our attention does not simply mean an opportunity to punish or sanction, but to help educate, counsel, and guide ourselves and others to where we should be. To make us better.

All of God’s creation needs light not only to live, but to thrive. We cannot grow any plants, make “vitamin D” in our bodies (I won’t give you a biochemistry lesson here, but we NEED sunlight for our bodies to make this), or find our way home in the dark. But lest you think I am just talking about physical light, we are talking about the spiritual Light – the Light of Christ – which should dwell inside each of us and illuminates us.

Where do we find this light? We all have it – through the sacrament of our baptism – yet how many of us have allowed the cares, dysfunctional behaviors, and other negative things – not only those directed at us but that we direct at others – to dim this Light?



## FROM FATHER PETER

We know how absence of external light makes us feel. But what about our internal Light? The lack or dimness of the Light of Christ in us has more profound effects on us, allowing all manner of darkness to take hold. It is here where Christ and His Light act as the ultimate and best “disinfectant”. To bring what needs to be fixed to our attention. To make us better.

This summer, as we enjoy our various pursuits and activities and enjoy the sunlight which God gives us, remember that His house is open, and it is there that we replenish the Light of Christ in us, every time we step through its doors, every time we partake of the mystery of Holy Communion.

And if you are a parent, and bringing your children to church has not been part of your weekly plan, and you haven’t come to church – especially at Assumption – in a long time, it is time to re-think this. The door is open to you especially, and the responsibility is yours to guide your families and bring them to the One who directed His disciples to let the children come to Him.

As a priest, and as a father and grandfather, engaging and welcoming our children and youth holds a special place. I welcome any parents to reach out to me directly, and work with me to explore what we can do to achieve this.

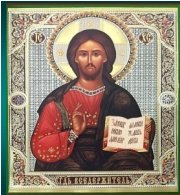

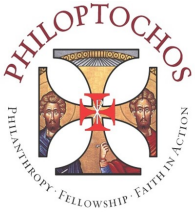

The Flint AHEPA-Daughters Scholarship Foundation is pleased to announce the recipients for this year's annual scholarships.







Any memorial donation checks not marked “*Assumption Church*” will be distributed for the purpose indicated on the check.

### Koliva

If anyone is in need of Koliva, please contact the church office (810-771-4611) for the names of those available to make it. The standard rate is \$150. **It is the responsibility of the family to arrange for Koliva.**

## ASSUMPTION GOC MEMBER POLICY

The current approved policy for Parishioner Status of the Assumption Greek Orthodox Church (AGOC) of Grand Blanc, Michigan is as follows:

**Parishioner** - Person Baptized and Chrismated according the rites of the Orthodox Church and attending the AGOC.

### **Parishioner - Member in Good Standing:**

- Person in compliance with Section 1 and 2 of Article 18 of the Uniform Parish Regulations of the Greek Orthodox Archdiocese.
- Person with an AGOC pledge card on file with a minimum pledge of \$600 per family or \$350 per single and current in pledges for active and preceding year.

**In-Active Parishioner** - Person not in compliance with requirements for Parishioner or Member in Good Standing as defined above.

Parishioners and In-Active Parishioners can receive all sacraments at AGOC but are required to pay church usage fee.

Any deviations from this policy must be approved by the Parish Priest and Parish Council President and must be presented to them at least one month prior to the proposed sacrament date.

**Stewardship Policy** - Only cash, check or credit card can be accepted as payment of stewardship. Donations of items or services cannot be accepted for stewardship in lieu of monetary payment.

### PROCEDURE FOR RECEIPTS

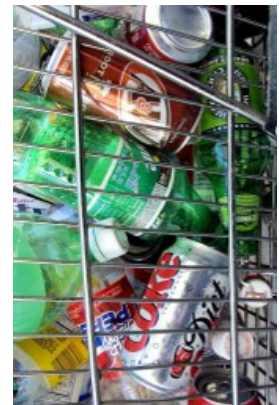




